Phenomenal Physiology – ****Deadline extended****

Aimed at Year 10 students, this project looks to bring Physiology to life by showing students it's real-world relevance and to consolidate learning in Biology and Sports Science. Students will participate in 4, 60 minute online workshops on consecutive weeks in which students will perform scientific experiments. They will be expected to submit their results and will submit a project write up at the end. Themes include reaction time and lung function. Phenomenal Physiology will run as an afterschool club remotely, on the school's MS Teams. Experiments can be conducted with easily obtainable materials and an exciting box of materials that we will send participants (either directly or via the school – whatever your preference) required for the experiments to be conducted. There will be certificates of participation and prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places.
