Admissions Procedure for Entry Into Year 7

Who Can Apply?

300 places are offered to children, who will be aged 11 by 1st September 2027.

9 places are allocated to the Resource Base by the Local Authority.

All other applicants will be required to complete an assessment. These assessments will test aptitude in non-verbal reasoning in line with the proposal in the Government White paper "Excellence in Schools", which encourages specialist schools to give priority to children who demonstrate the relevant aptitude.

30 places (10% of 300) will be allocated to those students achieving the highest marks in the assessment tests.

Up to 261 places allocated on criteria of:

1. Children in the care of the local authority or who previously were.
2. Children with a brother or sister already at the academy who will still be in attendance in September 2026.
3. Children attending a Ninestiles Summit Learning Trust.
4. Children who live nearest the academy.

Within each of these categories, priority is given to those who live nearest the academy, calculated on the basis of a straight-line measurement between home and academy.

Applications

Ninestiles Admissions for new Year 7 2027 will require all students in Year 6 to sit an assessment. The assessment will be held on Saturday 10th October. You must complete the Ninestiles application form for this by **Friday 25th September 2025**.

All applicants must also complete the Local Authority application form to be considered for a place at Ninestiles, as well as sitting the test. **Please contact your child's Primary School for instructions on how to fill out the information required to complete the Local Authority admissions form.** Contact details for the Local Authority are tel. 0121 303 1888.

Late applicants will be positioned on the distance waiting list after the initial offers are made to children who have completed our admissions process. Late entries from siblings are placed at the top of the distance waiting list and take priority.
